Review of results and brief report of the department activities and approval for feedback Report

Results of the previous examinations were found to be satisfactory.

Report of departmental activities and achievements:

1. Dept. of Psychology has signed a MoU with Manasa Trust, Shivamogga and Kateel Ashok Pai Memorial Institute (KAPMI), Shivamogga on 27th January 2022.
 2. 2 National webinars & 2 national level competition on account of world mental health day and world suicide prevention day, 2021 and 1 Workshop on account of International autism day.
 3. As a part of MOU with Center for Multidisciplinary Development Research Center (CMDR), Dharwad department organized a Guest lecture on Research in Social Sciences and Questionnaire preparation on 10th January 2022. The resource person was Dr. Vinod B. Annigere, Professor and Director, Center for Multidisciplinary Development Research Center (CMDR), Dharwad.
 4. Dr. Navyashree G C, has been awarded a Minor Research Grant of INR 3,50,000/ for the project titled “PSYCHOSOCIAL DISTRESS AMONG THE SURVIVORS OF CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE AND NEED FOR PERSONAL SAFETY AWARENESS AND EDUCATION PROGRAMME” by the Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR), Ministry of Human Resource Development.
- Around 12 research articles were presented at national and international conferences, 2 poster presentation and 7 research projects were applied from the dept.
 - 2 faculties have completed the online certificate courses through coursera.
 - 6 students from II MSc Psychology has published their research papers, 21 students have presented the paper at national and international conferences and 2 students have selected as a student

Revision and Approval of the syllabus

Dr. Navyashree G.C. presented the proposed revision of the content of the syllabus.

II Semester

PYH452: counseling skills – content of unit IV is merged with Unit III and the content related to areas of counseling is added as IV Unit.

Title of the paper PYH 452: Counselling skills was changed to Counseling skills and areas of Counseling.

III Semester

To include Trauma focused therapy's and Family therapy in PYH504: Psychotherapeutic interventions.

IV Semester

PYH552: Areas of Conselling and PYH554: Areas of Counselling practical were removed from IV Semester and the major content was added as IV Unit of PYH 452: Counselling skills.

Papers on internship and case were added as PYS552: Internship and PYH554: Case studies and field visit in IV Semester instead of the existing PYH552 Areas of counseling and PYS554: Areas of Counseling Practical.

PYS556: Marketing, advertising and consumer behavior

Unit I: Concepts related to customer relationship was removed and only concepts related to marketing are retained.

Unit IV: Foundation of advertisement and effective advertisement is removed as the concepts are not beneficial for the students of Psychology. Instead the concepts on consumer behavior is shifted from II Unit to Unit IV.

Title of the Paper PYS556 has been changed as Marketing and consumer behavior.

Board approved the modification is the syllabus and suggested to from the syllabus for PYH552: Internship and PYS554 case analysis.
