Revision and Approval of the syllabus

The syllabus earmarked for the academic year 2020-21 has been verified paper and unit wise. After a discussion it is resolved to incorporate the following sub topics in the syllabus.

- In paper I, Unit I: To include Coconut lethal yellowing and Coconut root decline as examples. (1 hour)
- In paper I, Unit II: To include ultra structure of Bacteria. (1 hour)
- In paper II, Unit I: To include the salient features of Zygomycetes, Ascomycetes, Basidiomycetes and Deuteromycetes with examples as per the Alexopolous system of classification. (2 hours)
- In paper III practical: To change the nomenclature as study of Dicot and Monocot endosperm and embryos by temporary mountings.













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- In paper VII; Unit- I: To include a note on photorespiration. (1 hour)
- In paper VII, Unit II: To add a note on pentose phosphate pathway. (1 hour) Board identified environmental, local National and global issues, incorporated in the syllabus The board approved the syllabus with modifications.
