## Agenda 4

A. The chairperson proposed to introduce 4 courses from the next academic year. It was the institutional policy to give more options for students and therefore additional courses are designed. The courses proposed are:

1. An Introduction to Academic writing (Soft core course),

2. Pictographic Interpretation of Literature (Open Elective course),

3. An Introductory Course in Translation (Open Elective course),

4. Research and Review Writing (Value Added Course)

The above courses have been designed and the same were presented for approval

The following inputs were given by the members:

### An Introduction to Academic writing (Soft core course)

(a) The nature of academic writing- its pedagogical or institutional context

(b) Types of academic writing with several examples

(c) Developing ideas and arguments in a continuous piece of writing



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(d) Logically arranging one's arguments
(e) Protocols of academic writing - clarity, validity of arguments, supporting evidence etc.
(f) The mechanics of academic writing
An Introductory Course in Translation (Open Elective course)
(1) Nature and needs of translation.
(2) S.L., T.L. and the readers of the translation.
(3) Identifying the type of the passage/ work to be translated - Literary, non-literary,

discursive, descriptive, argumentative.

- (4) Objectives of translation fidelity, transfer, communication etc.
- (5) Practising translation- from words to phrases to sentences to passages. (6) Discussion of
- problems and strategies in the lexical, syntactic and semantic areas.
- (6) To delete the word literary from the title

# Pictographic Interpretation of Literature (Open Elective course)

(1)To specify the texts for pictographic interpretation

- (2)To organize one workshop and have clarity about what exactly is expected outcome
- (3)To restructure the course giving emphasis on study of graphic/pictorial literature and the literary works with equal weights

The Board approved the proposed courses with the modifications suggested and the suggestion for changes in two papers

B. The changes suggested for clarity in papers ENG23HC and ENG24SC are: to replace 'Hunger' of Jayantha Mahapatra by his another poem' Indian Summer' in the paper ENG23HC; to specify the poems from Jejuri by Arun Kolatkar in the paper ENG24SC.The poems suggested are – 'An Old Woman' and 'Heart of Woman'
