Review and approval of the syllabus:

To highlight the topics related Gender equity, Human values, environment, Professional ethics; the local and national and Global issues; and skill component.

The draft of the syllabus developed based on the feedback collected from the stakeholders

The members noted all the components stated in the agenda and made the following recommendations:

- 1. To list out the topics related to Gender equity, Human values, Environment, Professional ethics; highlighting the Local and National and Global issues in the course; and Skill component in the syllabus.
- 2. To modify the title of the course 'Indian Writing in English' as 'Indian Writing in English and Translation'









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- 3. To change the question (unit-4) in Question paper pattern of 'Literary Criticism' in to 'Answer any two questions without leaving any text'
- 4. To delete the concepts in unit- 2 and add two essays (1. 'The Object of Study' by Ferdinand De Saussure 2. "An Image of Africa: Racism in Conrad's Heart of Darkness' by Chinua Achebe) in 'Literary Criticism' course.
- 5. To include two essays (1.'Modern Fiction' by Virginia Woolf, 2. 'Why the Novel Matters?' by D.H. Lawrence) in 'Modern Fiction' course and rename the title as Modern Fiction and Essays.

Topics highlighting the said issues were listed and the recommendations were accepted by the

The Board approved the syllabus with the modifications suggested. (Annexure-1- Syllabus)

Agenda 3

Approval for the additional elective papers:

As per the CBCS structure the institutions are expected to broaden the elective options to students. The autonomous status of the institution has provided ample opportunities to design syllabus and offer many elective courses. The Department has developed 14 elective courses to enable expanded scope, to enable to new discipline, to provide support to the discipline of study and to nurture learners' proficiency and skill. The draft syllabus of elective courses was presented for approval.

The members reviewed the syllabus of following elective Courses:

- 1. Translation (To provide an expanded scope)
- 2. Understanding Literary Criticism and Theory (To provide an expanded scope)
- 3 Understanding Literary terms and concepts (To provide an expanded scope)
- 4. Reading Fictional Writing (To provide an expanded scope)
- Technical Writing (Enabling to a new discipline) 5
- Reading Prose (Enabling to a new discipline) 6
- Writing Reviews (Enabling to a new discipline)
- 8. Reading Poetry (Enabling to a new discipline)
- Creative Writing (Supportive to the Discipline of Study)







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- 10. Audio Recording (Supportive to the Discipline of Study)
- 11. An Intensive Course in English Grammar(Supportive to the Discipline of Study)
- 12 Business English (Nurturing Students' Proficiency and Skill)
- 13. Profile Writing (Nurturing Students' Proficiency and Skill)
- 14 Report Writing Skills (Nurturing Students' Proficiency and Skill)

The Board approved the syllabus of all the above courses

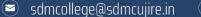

Suggestion 3:To motivate the students to undertake SWAYAM/ MOOC/ COURSERACourses available and earn extra credits. The faculty were suggested to identify appropriate topics/courses and motivate students to register and undertake the courses

Action Taken: Mr. Sooryanarayana Bhat has prepared a list of suitable courses available and communicated the students to enrol for these courses.

Implementation of NEP syllabus / question paper Pattern for the year 2021-22:

The draft syllabus was placed before the Board for deliberations. The members looked in to each detail and the components included in the syllabus and made the following observations:

- 1. The draft syllabus was the circulated syllabus prepared by the university. The structure and framework have been fully retained.
 - 2. The 20% of the syllabus has been modified in view of the provision made for the exercise of the autonomy.
 - 3. The draft syllabus has additional inputs like learning objectives, learning outcomes, preamble etc
 - The draft syllabus has Reflections-1 as study text in Generic English course in the place of Illuminations -1 prescribed by the University and each study component is brought under a theme and the translation course syllabus is expanded with further important topics for study

The University Nominee Prof. Rajalakshmi justified the modification as there is no deviation and additions are acceptable and justified. The department has carefully drafted outcomes and given a complete module for each course and all members lauded the efforts

However, if the institution provides provision for separate syllabus the Department can plan in the coming years for separate syllabus for all streams. The members approved this suggestion.

In view of the immediate need for a complete syllabus of the courses for 2021-22 batch the Board approved the draft syllabus.
