The members also suggested to include the following components along with the curriculum to enhance the soft skills needed for employability of the students

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Agenda - 3: Review of the question paper pattern:

The Board reviewed the question paper pattern and further it was resolved to have 12 short answer type questions in Part A drawn equally from 3 units out of which 9 questions are to be answered (marks: $9 \times 2 = 18$). In Part B, 4 questions are to be answered out of 6 questions drawn equally from 3 units selecting minimum of 1 question from each unit (marks: $13 \times 4 = 52$). Total of Part A and B: $18 + 52 = 70$ Marks.

Board approved the modified question paper pattern with effect from 2018-19.
